Comment:

The Piketon, Ohio area already technically qualifies as a superfund site - even if not so designated - due to radio-active contamination. There are terrible problems there with contamination due to past industrial abuse. I see no reason why a new plant would be different. Not only that, but Piketon will continue to be, and will be far more so, a nuclear waste dump due to the vast amounts of spent uranium waste that will remain after reprocessing. It is simply unacceptable to create indefinite - term storage of large quantities of nuclear waste in southern Ohio. Not only that, but I live essentially downwind of this plant during prevailing summer winds. I oppose this plant! Please do not build it!
