We have reviewed the "2004 Annual Site Inspection and Monitoring Report for Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act Title I Disposal Sites" and the "2004 Annual Site Inspection and Monitoring Report for Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act Title II Disposal Sites," both dated December 2004. The first report presented the results of annual inspections at 19 Title I uranium mill tailings sites. The second report provided similar information for the three Title II uranium mill tailings disposal sites that have been transferred to the Department of Energy for long-term surveillance and maintenance.
