Dear Mr. Glenn:

This letter is to request your cooperation in the transference of the above captioned NRC Material License for the licensing of radioactive materials was issued to Saint Mary's Hospital in connection with the merger of the Hospital into Cathedral Health Services, Inc., a New Jersey nonprofit corporation, effective January 1, 1990.

The Hospital is a member of a multi-hospital system controlled by Cathedral Healthcare System, Inc., under the auspices of the Archdiocese of Newark. In order to better serve the residents of Newark and the Oranges the three hospitals within the system, Saint James Hospital of Newark, Saint Michael's Medical Center, and Saint Mary's Hospital will each become, effective as of January 1, 1990, a division of Cathedral Health Services, Inc. This corporation will continue to be controlled by Cathedral Healthcare System, Inc.
