<u>Summary:</u> I left a message on Ms. Gore's voice-mail for her to get back in touch with me.		
11:00 Fred Fehlinger, Quality Manager returned my phone call. He stated that Ms. Gore delegated that task to him. Mr. Fehlinger informed me that he was confused by my phone call because the licensee was not undergoing bankruptcy proceedings. The last time they were in bankruptcy proceedings was in 2000 when Providence Health Care (PHC) took over their program. I stated that the phone call was part of the Bankruptcy Review Team process when the NRC becomes aware that a licensee might be having financial trouble. The phone call was made to confirm if a petition for bankruptcy had been made and to inform the licensee of any requirements in the regulations that might have to be followed. I thanked Mr. Fehlinger for the information and that I would be informing the BRT of the findings.
