(Granting Page Limit Extension Motion)

Upon consideration of the February 23, 2005 motion of applicant Louisiana Energy Services, L.P. (LES) for an extension of the page limit to respond to the February 2, 2005 motion of intervenors Nuclear Information and Resource Service and Public Citizen (NIRS/PC) for admission of a late-filed contention,¹ and there being no opposition thereto, it is

ORDERED, that the LES motion for a page limit extension is granted in that its response to the February 2 NIRS/PC filing shall not exceed twenty pages in length; and it is
