DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES

Nuclear reactor systems and components (10 CFR 110, Appendix A, Paragraphs (1)-(9)) and associated equipment and engineering services for construction, maintenance and operation of four 900 to 1500 MWe pressurized water reactors (AP1000 design). Two units are authorized for export to the San Men site in Zhejiang Province, and two units for the Yang Jiang site in Guangdong Province.


The total value of items authorized for export by this license is approximately \$2.5 billion. Items exported pursuant to this license shall be used only for the reactor units at the two sites specified, disposed of, or returned to the U.S. licensee. This license does not authorize exports of byproduct, source, or special nuclear materials.
