This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on February 8, 2005, at your facility in Mobridge, South Dakota. This inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the authority of Byproduct Materials License 40-17711-01 as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the license. At the conclusion of the inspection, preliminary inspection findings were conducted with your chief radiologic technologist, and a final exit briefing was conducted with you on February 22, 2005.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
