Very recently a report projected that nearby Charlottesville will run out of water by 2055 if current usage rates continue. Given the threat of a very real water shortage, it concerns me that the cooling system for Unit 3 will have a "MODERATE" impact during droughts, what about when there is NO water?

My second concern is that the potential rise in water temperature could be worse for local ecosystems than currently predicted.

Thirdly, I read recently that nuclear waste generated in the state of Virginia will not be permitted storage space in Yucca Mountain, Nevada (should that site be approved). I don't like the thought of nuclear waste being stored anywhere, because I don't think it's ever 100% safe, but I especially do not like the idea of having it in my backyard.
