ORDER

(Holding in Abeyance NRC Staff Motion for Protective Order)

On February 18, 2005, the NRC Staff filed a motion for a protective order covering access to, and disclosure of, certain purportedly sensitive unclassified information deleted from the publicly available version of its Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Mixed Oxide Fabrication Facility at the Savannah River Site. In responses filed February 28, 2005, both the Applicant, Duke Cogema Stone & Webster (DCS) and the Intervenor, Georgians Against Nuclear Energy (GANE), in effect, oppose the Staff motion.

As DCS and GANE indicate, there is no current need for a protective order because, at this time, neither of them seeks access to the supposedly sensitive information that the Staff seeks to protect. This being so, the Staff motion is premature and the motion will be held in abeyance until such time as a party to the proceeding seeks access to the information involved.

It is so ORDERED.
