Subject: Order Revoking License.		
<p><u>Summary:</u> I spoke Mr. Ritter about the Order revoking the license and the status of licensed activities. Mr. Ritter indicated that he had received the notices in August and September 2004 and forwarded them to Accounts Payable for resolution. He would have to speak with them regarding any action to pay the fees by the company. I informed him to contact Leah Tremper of NRC Headquarters and discuss the matter with her once he determines if action was taken to pay the fees. She would be able to tell him if the Order would remain in effect and what the fee would be with the interest added on. The Order requires that all licensed material be placed in secure storage until such time as a new license is issued by the Commission or the licensee disposes of all licensed material. Mr. Ritter stated that the researchers are currently not using any material, that licensed material is only used in one laboratory, and that he will inform the researchers not to perform any experiments using licensed material. I thanked Mr. Ritter for his cooperation in this matter.</p> <p>3/3/05 09:45 Mr. Ritter called back. He stated that he had spoken with Leah Tremper after determining that the fees had not been paid. The licensee would have to apply for a new license and asked what would be the easiest way to apply. He also asked what was the most recent correspondence sent to the licensee regarding the revocation of the license. I found that the most recent letter sent to the licensee was sent on January 12, 2005. The letter, however, did not indicate to whom the letter was sent. Mr. Ritter indicated that the license submission would be sent to the NRC as quickly as possible.</p>
