ORDER REGARDING STATE'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF FINAL PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION

The Licensing Board has before it the State's March 7 Motion for Reconsideration.

Assuming the continuing validity of the former Appeal Board's analysis in Consumers Power

Co. (Midland Plant, Units 1 and 2), ALAB-235, 8 AEC 645, 646-47 (1974), the State's Motion would appear to have been properly and timely filed under 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.771(a) and 2.710.

As to the State's concurrent requests to us and to the Commission (see Motion, p. 10) for a correlative extension of time to file a Petition for Review, however, we deem that to be a matter for determination by the Commission, not by us. <u>See, e.g., Midland,</u> 8 AEC at 647-48, where an analogous motion was addressed by the Appeal Board, not by the Licensing Board.

The Applicant's and the Staff's responses to the pending State Motion for Reconsideration are to be in the Board's hands by close of business Monday, March 21. Cf. 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.771(b) and 2.710.

It is so ORDERED.
