SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

SUMMARY

Certificate of Compliance No. 5805, for the Model No. CNS 3-55 package, has been revised to reflect the new 10 CFR Part 71 regulations (69 FR 3698) that became effective on October 1, 2004. Duratek, Inc., did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents.

EVALUATION

The following changes have been made to the certificate:

- Condition No. 11 of the certificate was revised to clarify that the package is approved for use under the general license provisions of 10 CFR 71.17. This change is due to a revision in the numbering of the sections in 10 CFR Part 71, that became effective on October 1, 2004 (69 FR 3698).
- Condition No. 12 was changed to reflect the new expiration date. In accordance with 10 CFR 71.19(a)(3), Type B() packages are no longer authorized for use after October 1, 2008.

CONCLUSION

These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
