AND 2, LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION (TAC NOS. MC4641 AND  
MC4642)

Environmental scoping meetings were conducted to support the review of the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2 (BSEP) license renewal applications submitted by Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L), now doing business as Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. Two public meetings were conducted on Thursday, January 27, 2005, at the Southport City Hall, 201 E. Moore Street, Southport, North Carolina. Approximately 40 people attended the meetings, including members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff, NRC contractors from Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, members of the public, representatives from CP&L, news media, and local government officials. Seven individuals provided comments during the meetings, all of the comments were in support of license renewal for BSEP. A combined listing of attendees for both sessions is provided in Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 is a copy of the meeting handouts. Enclosures 3 and 4 contain the official corrected transcripts for the afternoon and evening meetings, respectively. Enclosure 5 contains the slides used during the NRC's presentation.
