This refers to your license amendment request dated February 2, 2005. Please note that 10 CFR 35.24(c) allows appointment of a temporary Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for only 60 days each year. Dr. Jimenez's letter indicated that you will perform the duties of RSO for four months. Therefore we have amended this license to list you as RSO. When Dr. Jimenez returns from active duty, you may request to amend the license again to rename him as RSO.

Enclosed with this letter is the amended license. Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
