PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

- 3. **ROUTINE USE(S):** This information may be used for transmittal to the U.S. Treasury for payment; to the Department of State or an embassy for passports or visas; and to the General Services Administration and the Office of Management and Budget for required periodic reporting. The information may be disclosed to an appropriate Federal, State, local or Foreign agency in the event the information indicates a violation or potential violation of law and in the course of an administrative or judicial proceeding.
