Dear Sir or Madam:

As we have previously disclosed to you via the above referenced letters, FWENC has contracted the services of Tetra Tech FW, Inc. to continue the implementation of the ISF Facility Project. The purpose of this letter is to inform the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that, effective January 20, 2005, Tetra Tech FW, Inc. changed its name to Tetra Tech EC, Inc. This name change was consistent with prior agreements between FWENC and Tetra Tech Inc. relating to the sale of FWENC selected assets to Tetra Tech Inc. on March 7, 2003. It is important to note that this change is a change in name only. There is no impact on the ISF Facility License or on the conclusions reached in the NRC Safety Evaluation Report.

The activities of the Tetra Tech EC, Inc. employees continue to be governed by a subcontract (previously provided you), and are performed at the pleasure of, and at the direction of the FWENC Executive Director for the ISF Project. In this light, we have previously granted Mr. Donald I. Rogers, Jr. and Mr. Ronald D. Izatt the authority to represent FWENC on matters before the NRC. In that capacity, these individuals may continue to sign, on FWENC's behalf, ISF Facility related documents, including those that may be required under oath and affirmation. This approach is consistent with regulatory approvals granted for 10 CFR Part 50 licensees and is consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 72.50 in that no transfer of license authority has occurred. FWENC clearly retains the authority and responsibility for the licensing, construction, and safe operation of the ISF Facility and for regulatory compliance.
