NRC STAFF'S INITIAL STATUS REPORT ON REVIEW SCHEDULE

In its Initial Scheduling Order, dated February 1, 2005,¹ the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board") directed the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("Staff") to submit a short report estimating the date when the draft and final versions of the Safety Evaluation ("SE"), environmental assessment ("EA") and report of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards ("ACRS Report") will be issued. The Staff herein provides its initial status report.

In short, the Staff is currently unable to provide a projected schedule for issuance of the SE, EA and ACRS Report due to continued delays in the submission of necessary application supplements. During the January 21, 2005 prehearing conference call, counsel for the Staff advised the Licensing Board and the parties that the Staff was awaiting submission of additional supplements to the application and responses to requests for additional information ("RAIs"). The applicants provided some information in submissions dated February 24 and March 10, 2005. These submissions are currently being evaluated in order to determine whether additional information will be required in order for the Staff to complete its review. Further, the Staff is still awaiting additional submissions from the applicants, now expected on March 22 and March 31, 2005.

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Once the Staff completes its review of all material received, it will be better able to re-assess the overall review schedule.
