Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: Most of the burden for this collection is captured under §75.21(b) (material accounting and control procedure recordkeeping requirements) and is estimated to be 400 hours per licensee. The burden has increased from 2,400 hours to 2,800 hours because the average number of licensees selected by IAEA to participate in the US/IAEA Safeguards Agreement will increase from 6 to 7 (6 licensees @ 2,400 hours to 7 licensees @ 2,800 hours).

There has been an increase in the overall cost as a result of an increase in the rate from \$144/hr to \$157/hr.
