NRC called to inform Holtec that the staff has made a determination that as a result of the staffs acceptance review the information submitted in LAR 1014-3 to the Holtec HI-STORM 100 storage design was incomplete. Specifically, issues were identified, with respect to the structural analyses, and areas of the application which did not contain sufficient information or bases to allow the staff to continue with the review. As such the staff informed Holtec that the application cannot be accepted and the review continued at this time. Holtec was offered three options 1) Holtec could withdraw the application in it's entirety, 2) the staff could issue a letter to Holtec indication the non-acceptance of the application and termination of the review with the details of the determination attached, or 3) Holtec could request, in a letter, the staff discontinue work on the application while they prepare a supplement to address the staffs concerns. The letter would request the staff provide Holtec with the results of the acceptance review. Holtec indicated they will choose option 3. The staff indicated that prior to submittal of the application supplement a public meeting should be scheduled to ensure that all the staffs issues have indeed been addressed. Holtec agreed this to be an appropriate path forward.
