Subject: Gauge Model numbers & Leak test information			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>The licensee requested to change the mailing and storage addresses that are currently listed on the license. Currently, the authorized material does not list the model numbers of the sealed sources, and in order to avoid unnecessary paper work related to two amendments (for change of storage location), I called the licensee to determine what type (manufacturer & model numbers) of the gauges that they currently possess. (The inspection conducted on 2-25-03 documented that the licensee had Troxler 3400 series gauges). I also asked the licensee if they ever had any report of a leaking source while the gauges were stored at the current location.</p> <p>Mr. Noll stated that they currently own 3 Troxler 3400 series gauges. He also stated that the gauges were leak tested recently and these results as well as the past results of the leak tests never indicated that the any of the gauges was leaking licensed material. He also stated that the gauges are not used every day and most of the times once or twice a week.</p> <p>I also reminded him that his license expires next year, and if he wished he could submit a new application for renewal so that he would not need to worry about renewal for another 10 years, and if he wishes, I could guide him to obtain the guidance and application material from the internet. He liked the idea and I helped him get the material from NRC web site. He will fax a new application tomorrow.</p>
