ORDER

On March 17, 2005, Exelon Generation Co., LLC (EGC) filed a Motion for Summary Disposition of Contention 3.1. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.710, the NRC Staff and the Intervenors, Environmental Law and Policy Center, Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League, Nuclear Energy Information Service, Nuclear Information and Resource Service, and Public Citizen have twenty (20) days to file a response (i.e. all responses are due in our offices on or before noon on April 6, 2005). If any of such responses contain new facts or arguments supporting the motion, any party opposing the motion shall respond thereto within ten (10) days after such response has been served.

In addition, we call to the attention of all Intervenors that the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Clinton ESP Permit (NUREG 1815 DRAFT) was issued by the staff under cover letter dated March 8, 2005, and that late filing of amendment of contentions (and the filing

of new contentions) based upon information therein contained will be required to satisfy both the standard for late filing set forth in 10 C.F.R. § 2.309(c) and the general contention admissibility requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.309(f).

It is so ORDERED.
