OBJECTIONS ON BEHALF OF INTERVENORS  
NUCLEAR INFORMATION AND RESEARCH SERVICE  
AND PUBLIC CITIZEN TO PROPOSED TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS

Preliminary statement

Pursuant to the Memorandum and Order of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dated March 10, 2005, Petitioners Nuclear Information and Resource Service and Public Citizen ("NIRS/PC") hereby object to certain transcript corrections submitted by Louisiana Energy Services, L.P. ("LES") on February 28, 2005.

NIRS/PC have no objection to the proposed corrections submitted on behalf of the Commission Staff on February 28, 2005.

Objections to corrections proposed by LES:

1. LES correction No. 10 is said to refer to page 468, lines 6-7, and the relevant text does not appear at that place in the transcript supplied by the court reporter.  
Therefore, NIRS/PC object to the correction.

2. LES correction No. 11 is said to refer to page 469, lines 3 and 5, and the relevant text does not appear at those places in the transcript supplied by the court reporter.

Therefore, NIRS/PC object to the correction.

3. LES correction No. 34 is said to refer to page 574, lines 18 through 22. The text referred to appears at page 574, lines 14 through 16, in the transcript supplied by the court reporter. The proposed correction would insert the word "if." NIRS/PC object and submit that the Board should listen to the court reporter's tape to determine whether that word was spoken.

4. LES correction No. 40 is said to refer to page 604, lines 6 through 9. The text referred to appears at page 604, lines 1 through 5, in the transcript supplied by the court reporter. NIRS/PC believe that the transcript should state (at page 604, lines 1 through 5):

WITNESS HARPER: Yes, there is. And LES is committed to a very high level of installation oversight during the design and construction of the basins.

MR. LOVEJOY: And the design of these basins is not complete.

Is that right?

5. Concerning LES correction No. 83 (page 947, line 19), NIRS/PC believe that the transcript should state:

MR. LOVEJOY: I should like to make a proffer.

6. Concerning LES correction No. 154 (page 1507, line 18), NIRS/PC believe that the transcript should state:

MR. LOVEJOY: Okay.


