1. Please confirm that your proposed location of use, listed in item 3 of your application, is not a location of use for any other active NRC license.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: To the best of our knowledge, there are no other active NRC licenses in use at the facility listed in item 3 of our application.

2. Confirm whether you have completed the examination referenced in your application successfully and your skills and abilities were observed to be satisfactory. If not, then confirm that the above will occur before the initiation of licensed activities.

<u>RESPONSE:</u> Included with this response is an amendment request to our original application. This amendment request replaces the proposed RSO (Mr. Richard Timbo) with Mr. Michael Shane Brightwell. Additionally, Mr. Timbo will be trained as an Authorized User (AU) and will oversee the day-to-day licensed activities as Licensed Activities Supervisor.

Mr. Timbo, along with other applicable employees at the facility, will be trained prior to the initiation of licensed activities.

3. Since you will be receiving or have received the training referenced in your application, confirm that Mr. Brightwell is/was the instructor. Alternatively, indicate how the training will be/was provided (i.e., self-study, teleconference, videotape, etc.).

<u>RESPONSE:</u> Mr. Brightwell, now submitted as the applicant RSO, will perform initial on-site training for Mr. Timbo and other applicable employees commensurate with each individual's responsibilities with respect to licensed activities. Additionally, these individuals have been provided the Basic Radiation Training document to review/study prior to on-site training.

4. Confirm that there will be training prior to the first performance of licensed activities, refresher training on an annual basis, and retraining whenever there is a change in relevant regulations and/or a change in duties of the individual performing licensed activities.

<u>RESPONSE:</u> The following training activities will be performed –

- Initial training will be conducted prior to the first performance of licensed activities.
- Refresher training will be performed on an annual basis.
- Retraining will be performed whenever there is a change in

- o relevant regulations, or
- o duties of any individual performing licensed activities.
- 5. Your application in item 10 indicates that you will be performing "quality control checks of a fraction on individual SSD packages." If the time pieces are to be disassembled, then please commit to the performance of area surveys for contamination after the quality control checks and bioassays of the workers involved. Otherwise state that the timepieces will not be disassembled.

<u>**RESPONSE:</u>** Timepieces will not be disassembled at the licensed facility.</u>

6. Your application states under item 11, "Waste Management" that the licensee will follow the protocol of collecting and returning all damaged Sealed Source Devices (SSDs [i.e., timepieces]) and SSDs with failed Gaseous Tritium Light Sources to the overseas manufacturing facility. Confirm that you will perform surveys of the shipment in which you find such damaged devices to determine if your facility or other packages in the shipment become contaminated from the damaged devices.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Contamination surveys will be performed on shipments found to contain damaged timepieces. The surveys will be performed and results will be evaluated by the RSO using the Department of Transportation 49 CFR 173.443 criteria as applicable to determine subsequent actions with respect to other packages in the shipment.

Additionally, if any shipment is found to contain damaged timepieces, subsequent contamination surveys will be performed on potentially impacted areas of the facility (loading dock, handling and storage areas, support equipment, etc.). The results will be evaluated by the RSO to determine to what extent remedial action options need to be considered.
