Definition/Goal

The number of on-line corrective maintenance work orders in the backlog does not include elective maintenance.

Analysis and Actions

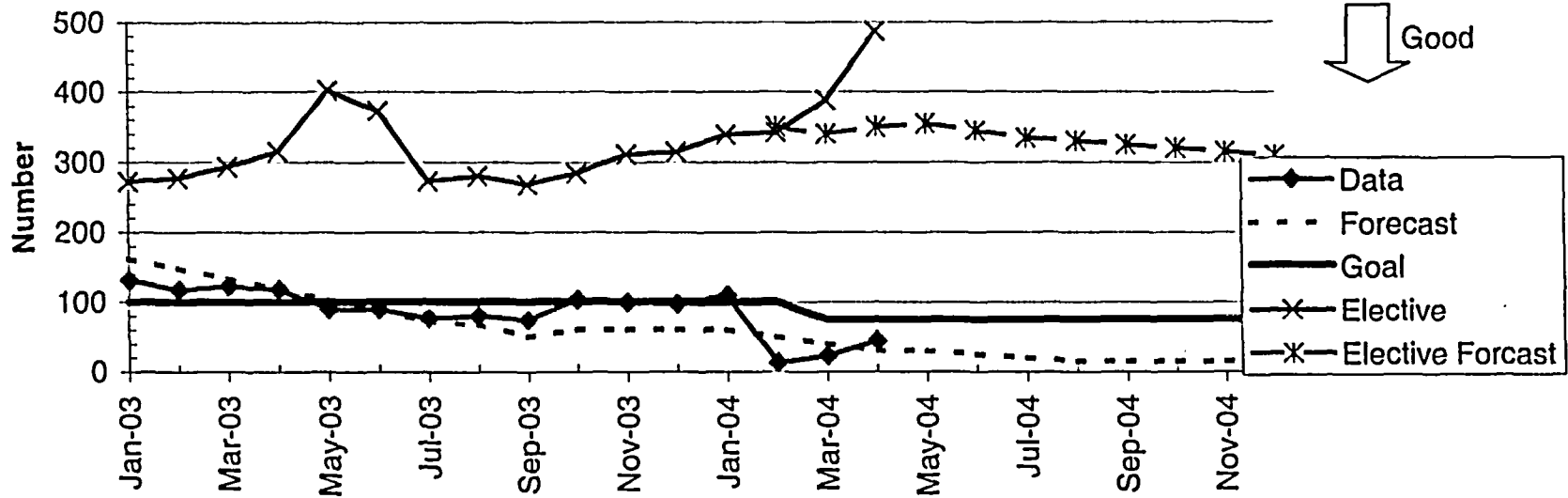
Analysis: Current corrective backlog remains below goal level but above forecast level. Review and oversight will support decreases. Outage preparations and performance decreased manpower available for corrective and elective maintenance support.

Meets: Two Units < 75
 Exceeds: Two Units < 60
 Actual 45

Action: A review of new items continues to be conducted. Increase utilization of the FIN team, implementation of short cycle maintenance, and pre-planned overtime will be used to assist in the continued reduction. Continued support of the PMO effort will assist in long range improvement in corrective maintenance backlog.
