We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region V final exercise report, dated February 25, 2005, for the November 17, 2004, Plume Exposure Pathway Exercise at the Braidwood Station (ADAMS Accession No. ML050820186).

One Area Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) was identified by FEMA Region V staff regarding the performance of Will County and then corrected. Four ARCAs were identified regarding performance of the State of Illinois of which two were corrected during the exercise.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
