Enclosed is Amendment No. 72 to your NRC Material License No. 24-06806-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that you and Dr. Ingle were not listed for 10 CFR 35.300 materials at this time for therapeutic procedures since more information concerning your preceptors are necessary. Please provide documentation from the University of Tennessee for Dr. Massie and University of Arkansas Medical Science center for Dr. Thomas which verifies their authorization for the equivalent of 10 CFR 35.300 material. Since Tennessee and Arkansas are Agreement States, NRC does not maintain license files for these States. Please provide this information and reference Control Number 314061. In addition, you requested Andrew Daniel to be listed as an authorized medical physicist (AMP) for 35.400 material. NRC does not require medical physicist to be listed on an NRC license for 10 CFR 35.400 material. If in the future you request material in 10 CFR 35.600 and/or 35.1000, Mr Daniel's qualifications would permit him to be listed as an authorized medical physicist. Also the State of Georgia's license that you provided is not legible in the section titled, "Authorized Uses.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <u>http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html</u> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).

Please note that on October 25, 2004, the NRC suspended public access to ADAMS, and initiated an additional security review of publicly available documents to ensure that potentially sensitive information is removed from the ADAMS database accessible through the NRC's web site.
