<u>Summary</u>: I spoke with the receptionist who indicated that the company was selling its interest in radioactive materials. She transferred me to Guy Davis the president of the company. I left a message on Mr. Davis' voice-mail for him to get back in touch with me.

13:15 Mr. Davis returned my call. He confirmed that the licensee is in the process of terminating all licensed activities. All of the sealed sources are to be donated to the University of Georgia. Due to down-sizing, the Radiation Safety Officer is no longer a full-time employee but a consultant. He believed that the payment of fees each November allowed for the renewal of the license each year. I explained that the annual fees are separate from the renewal process and that the licensee would need to maintain the license if the sealed sources are kept beyond March 31, 2005. I stated that he should send in a letter requesting renewal of the license but as "storage only" pending transfer of the sources to the University of Georgia. Mr. Davis agreed to send in the request.
