The 3660 gauge can have either of two source housings. We were finally able to get the owner of the gauge to lay his hands on it and tell us exactly what he has. So my email to you last week was mostly correct. The gauge system is a KayRay 3660. But the actual device that is registered is the housing, which is a Model 7062-BP containing 100 mCi of Cs-137. The registry number I sent last week is inactive; the current registry certificate is attached for your review. I will give you a call sometime tomorrow morning and follow up with a corrected letter if needed. Thank you so much for your help and patience.
