9. Authorized use:

- A. through J. For possession incident to service for other persons as defined in 10 CFR 20.1003 for:
- (1) Installation, initial radiation surveys, relocation, removal from service, dismantling, alignment, replacement, packaging of the sealed source, and repair of components related to the radiological safety of devices listed in Attachment 2 of the letter dated October 30, 2001 and letter dated March 17, 2005, that have been registered either with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission under 10 CFR 32.210 or with an Agreement State.
 - (2) Leak test sample collection.
 - (3) Instruction of customers.
 - (4) Preparation and packaging for the purpose of transportation, disposal, or relocation of devices containing the sealed sources, that have been registered either with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission under 10 CFR 32.210 or with an Agreement State.
- K. Analysis of leak test and environmental samples as a service for other persons as defined in 10 CFR 20.1003.

CONDITIONS

10. A. Licensed material listed in Items 6.A. through 6.J. may be used at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.
- B. Licensed material listed in Item 6.K. may be used at the licensee's facility located at 600 State Street, Clairton, Pennsylvania.
11. A. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, Glenn R. Marshall, James Ferree, Paul T. Hrezo or James D. Alderson.
- B. The Radiation Safety Officer for this license is Glenn R. Marshall.

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12. In addition to the possession limits in Item 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d), 40.36(b), and 70.25(d) for establishing financial assurance for decommissioning.
13. Sealed sources containing licensed material shall not be opened by the licensee.
14. The licensee is authorized to transport licensed material in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 71, "Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material."
15. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
