During an internal review of your license amendment, it was observed that the authorization for Eric Fielding, M.D. was not consistent with the hospital's authorization for 35.100 and 35.200 materials, in that iodine-131 use in excess of 30 microcuries is not authorized. Therefore Condition No. 12 has been changed to correct the authorized material and use for Eric Fielding, M.D..


MATERIALS LICENSE
