## SUMMARY

By application dated March 15, 2005, Source Production & Equipment Co., Inc. (SPEC), requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9056, for the Model No. SPEC 2-T package. SPEC did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

## EVALUATION

By application dated March 15, 2005, SPEC requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9056, for the Model No SPEC 2-T package. SPEC did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

Condition No. 11 of the certificate was revised to clarify that the package is approved for use under the general license provisions of 10 CFR 71.17. This change is due to a revision in the numbering of the sections in 10 CFR Part 71, that became effective on October 1, 2004 (69 FR 3698).

## CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a term that expires on April 30, 2010. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
