1. The contract is hereby modified to add the work described in the attached table. It is agreed that this work shall be completed by June 30, 2005. In addition, \$36,758 in cost and fee is hereby authorized in proposal preparation costs for the ROM cost estimates and descriptions for the Voice Subsystem and IT Infrastructure requirements outlined in the NRC CO's letter to Digitalnet dated November 26, 2004.

1. As a result of the above changes, the contract estimated cost and fixed fee are adjusted as shown below:

2. Funding in the amount of \$200,000 is allotted to this contract in support of this contract modification. As a result, Section B.4 of the contract is hereby replaced with the following revised Section B.4:

B.4 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION

(a) The total estimated cost to the Government for full performance of this contract is \$6,229,913.41 of which \$5,857,460.94 represents the reimbursable costs and of which \$372,452.47 represents the fixed fee.

(b) The amount currently obligated with respect to this contract is \$5,194,706.40 of which the sum of \$4,884,143 represents funds for the reimbursable costs and \$310,563.40 represents funds for the fixed fee.

3. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
