

PROGRAM SCOPE

This license authorizes 35.100, 35.200, and I-131 use at two private practice outpatient imaging centers. These are operated by a large group of radiologists that staffs numerous outpatient imaging centers and one hospital. This was an unannounced, routine inspection.

The facility in Absecon, New Jersey operates under the name of "Community Radiology." There is one imaging camera and one technologist per day. Usual hours of operation are 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The primary technologist works 4 days per week (all except Thursday). Patient volume is 2 to 5 studies per day. Standard diagnostic studies are performed, except that occasional MUGA scans are the only cardiac studies. The most frequent examinations are bone scans and thyroid studies using state-licensed I-123. An occasional lung ventilation scan is performed using Tc-99m DTPA aerosol. Only unit doses are used and all are assayed in a dose calibrator prior to administration. Procedures performed under 35.300 include I-131 whole body scans and treatment of hyperthyroidism, with treatments typically not exceeding 15 mCi. The number of I-131 administrations requiring a written directive is 3 year-to-date in 2004, with a total of 8 in 2003. The RSO is an AU who is typically on-site one day per week, usually on Wednesday. Jonathan Law's group (usually Bob Shomo) provides consultant physics services. They are on-site at least once per quarter and perform audits.

The facility in Cinnaminson, New Jersey operates under the name of "Regional Radiology" and was added to the license in 2001. This location was previously listed on a different NRC license: 29-30463-01. There is one imaging camera and one technologist. Usual hours of operation are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Nuclear Medicine services are currently provided 2-3 days per week: Tuesdays and Wednesdays each week and every second Thursday. Patient volume is 3 to 4 studies per day of operation. Standard diagnostic studies are performed, except that occasional MUGA scans are the only cardiac studies. Bone scans are the most frequent examinations. Only unit doses are used and all are assayed in a dose calibrator prior to administration. No 35.300 procedures are performed at this location. The RSO is an AU who is typically on site 1-2 times per year, but is typically based at one of the other outpatient imaging centers. He is accessible by telephone at all times. One of the other AU's, Dr. Babaria, is at this location most days. Mike Nunno is the consultant physicist. He is on-site approximately once per quarter and performs audits.

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Community Radiology has a second NRC license issued for the Absecon, New Jersey address: 29-30289-02. This is a mobile scan-in-van license, authorizing the Absecon address as the base location. This license was recently amended to authorize a fixed location in Cape May Court House, New Jersey. The licensee moved all equipment from the vehicle to the fixed site a few weeks ago and is preparing to submit an amendment request to remove the mobile authorization.

Prior to the conclusion of the inspection, the licensee submitted amendment requests to cause the licenses to better reflect the organization of their current programs. They requested the Absecon and Cape May Courthouse fixed site locations to be combined under a single license. They requested the Cinnaminson location to be on a separate license under the name "Regional Radiology" with Dr. Babaria as RSO.
