## ORDER

(Granting Joint Motion For Extension Of Time To Conduct Settlement Negotiations)

On March 2, 2005, this Board granted the parties' joint motion to hold this proceeding in abevance for 40 days, until April 11, 2005, to allow them to pursue settlement negotiations.

On April 5, 2005, the parties submitted another joint motion seeking a 42-day extension of time to continue their settlement discussions. In their motion, the parties state that they have met several times and identified a number of significant points of agreement; however, some matters could not be resolved without gathering additional information, which may take several weeks. They state they "are optimistic that such information will provide a basis for resolution that is acceptable to each of the parties," and that "an additional 42 days should be sufficient for them to conclude their negotiations."

On the basis of those representations, we <u>grant</u> the motion. The schedule set forth in the March 2<sup>nd</sup> order is therefore no longer in effect, and this proceeding will be held in abeyance for an additional 42 days, until <u>May 23, 2005</u>, to allow the parties to conclude their settlement discussions.

The parties are directed to notify the Board promptly if a settlement is successfully negotiated or if it is determined that one is not possible. If we do not hear from them earlier, the parties shall – midway through the 42-day abeyance period, on May 2, 2005 – submit a joint status report informing the Board of the progress that has been made in the settlement process. If necessary, the parties shall submit another joint status report at the conclusion of the abeyance period, on May 23, 2005.
