
**RE:** March 30, 2005 Memorandum and Order

The Panel has previously provided the Intervenors with 45 days after the issuance of the EIS to file written testimony and supporting affidavits regarding the admitted contention. See October 27, 2004 Order (Establishing Hearing Schedule) and October 19, 2004 conference call (Tr. at 441-42). Intervenors request that the Panel clarify its March 30, 2005 Memorandum and Order to likewise provide this same 45-day period for any substantive challenge to the Draft EIS and additional Exelon analysis regarding Contention 3.1 that the Intervenors may file. Counting from the March 8, 2005 filing of the Draft EIS, any such substantive challenge would be due on April 22, 2005.


