Additional Response to the August 18, 2004 NRC Order
for Unescorted Access Authorization at the ISFSI

In letter VPN-050-2004, dated September 07, 2004, Portland General Electric (PGE) informed the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of our schedule for compliance with the Additional Security Measures (ASMs) required by the Commission Order dated August 18, 2004. The schedule provided by PGE indicated that full compliance with the ASMs contained in the Order would be achieved on or before August 18, 2005. The Order requires PGE to notify the Commission when full compliance with the ASMs described in the Order is achieved. It is the purpose of this letter to respond to an NRC staff request to provide interim compliance status information.

Compliance with all ASMs of the order, except for item B.4, was achieved on or before February 11, 2005. Compliance with item B.4 will be achieved on or before August 18, 2005.
