This letter is in response to your request for clarification of our amendment request referenced above.

I confirmed with Dr. Robert Moser, MD, the Medical Director of the Pathology department, that the RIA lab had not been used in approximately 14 years. The isotope that had been used in the department was I-123. There is not a close-out survey available, but based on the half-life of the isotope (13hrs.) I would conclude that there is no longer any activity in the area.

Also, I confirmed with Dr. Jack Yang, Ph.D., consultant therapy physicist, that the Sr-90 eye applicator has been shipped for disposal and is no longer at St. Francis Medical Center.
