Subject: Questions Regarding Telephone Deficiency.		
<p><u>Summary:</u> Mr. Durkee left a voice-mail message for me about the March 21, 2005 Deficiency Letter to get back in touch with him.</p> <p>11:00 I called Mr. Durkee and went over the four questions that needed answering on the deficiency letter. I confirmed that the NRC needs the IND number, isotope, form and quantity for each IND that the licensee will have and that ones no longer in use will be deleted. We discussed the training and experience of Drs. Kaplan and Winkle and determined that they should only be authorized for 10 CFR 31.11. Dr. Murtaugh's experience and training came from only the University of Wisconsin. The licensee would need to obtain a letter from the RSO of the University of Wisconsin confirming the training and experience received there. Dr. Murtaugh was licensed to perform activities in the State of Connecticut. The licensee would be receiving unit doses from their suppliers and therefore would not need to measure the dosages. Mr. Durkee stated that once all of the information is received, a letter would be drafted and signed by the licensee.</p>
