Gentlemen:

During an inspection of George Mason University's Material License No. 45-13147-01, it was brought to our attention by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission that the possession limits currently permitted in the license require Mason to provide financial assurance for decommissioning. Mason has never possessed radioactive materials quantities for which financial assurance is required and, therefore; we would like to amend our license to remove the requirement for financial assurance.

Please amend our license to indicate that usage of radioactive materials is restricted to those materials which have a half life equal to or less than 120 days, with the following exceptions:
