SUMMARY OF INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUEST

Title: Grant and Cooperative Agreement Provisions

Current Burden/Responses: 1,055 hours/88 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 1,160 hours/148 responses

Frequency of Response: On occasion

Number of Respondents: 60

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The overall burden has increased by 105 hours, from 1,055 hours to 1,160 hours. The total hours are based on the actual number of grant/cooperative agreement responses received during the past three years and the projected grant/cooperative agreement responses to be received during this upcoming three year period. The additional 105 hours are due to the capture of recordkeeping burden. There also has been an increase in cost due to the increase in the NRC's standard fee recoverable rate for materials licensees from \$144 per hour to \$157 per hour
