I am writing to ask that you reject the plan to build a new reactor at Clinton.

The people of this country have worked long and hard to stop the tragedy of nuclear based energy. It is dangerous, costly, unhealthy and really rather insane. We have the technology for safe and sustainable energy production right now. We have only to develop and use it.

Illinois already has more nuclear reactors than any other state and has tremendous untapped renewable energy potential. As a nation, we can't afford to start down the road of nuclear power again, after a 30-year hiatus. Nuclear power continues to rely heavily on taxpayer subsidies because it is so expensive, and draft language in the energy bill in the current Congress indicates billions more dollars could be on the way. There is still no solution to the waste problem; the proposed nuclear waste dump at Yucca Mountain is in a downward spiral and wouldn't be large enough to hold waste from a new reactor even if it did go forward. Safety continues to be sacrificed in favor of higher profits by both the industry and the NRC. And security standards at nuclear plants are downright pathetic.
