Pursuant to Reference 1, USEC Inc. (USEC) hereby submits to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) additional information related to the Request for Additional Information (RAI) on the License Application and supporting documents for the American Centrifuge Plant.

Enclosure 1 to this letter provides revised responses as specified in Reference 1. Enclosure 2 contains drawings requested in NRC RAI Question LA-1. Enclosure 3 contains an Annex to the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan as requested in NRC RAI Question FN-4. As a result of the additional responses in Enclosure 1 of this letter, additional (non-proprietary) changes have been made to Chapters 1.0, 3.0, and 7.0 of the License Application and will be submitted under separate cover (AET 05-0019). Revision 2 to the Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA) Summary and Addendum 1 of the ISA Summary will be provided under separate cover (AET 05-0026).

Enclosures 1 through 3 contain USEC Proprietary Information. Accordingly, USEC requests that the documents in Enclosures 1 through 3 be withheld from the public disclosure pursuant to 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 2.390(a)(4) and (d)(1). An affidavit required by 10 CFR 2.390(b)(1)(ii) is provided in Enclosure 4. In addition, Enclosures 1 through 3 have been determined, in accordance with the guidance provided by the U.S. Department of Energy, to contain Export Controlled

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
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Information. This information must be protected from disclosure per the requirements of 10 CFR Part 810.
