<p><u>Summary:</u> I left a message on Jesus Collara's and Jose B. Noel Irizarry's voice-mails for them to get back in touch with me.</p> <p>Mr. Irizarry returned my call. I asked Mr. Irizarry if a request to terminate the license had been sent in as stated to the inspector during the inspection in January 2005. I informed him that as of this time we had received a notification of the licensee's intent to terminate the license but a final survey had not been received showing there was no residual contamination and no licensed material on-site. Mr. Irizarry stated that he would look into the matter.</p> <p>4/19/05 Richard A. Hughes, Corporate Radiation Safety Officer called to inform me that 90 percent of the paperwork for the termination request has been compiled. He wanted to complete the package and make sure that all of the licensed material was off-site prior to submitting the request. He estimates that the package should be in the mail to Region I by Friday.</p>
