Mr. Capasso was responsible for driving and unloading truckloads of waste collected at Ledoux on Friday April 8 and Monday April 11, 2005. He reported that the waste had been picked up from Ledoux by driver Carl Ciampi on the morning of April 9 (for trash deposited at Ledoux on 4/8) and April 12 (for trash deposited at Ledoux on 4/11) respectively. On each day, the truck was driven by him to the Miele Transfer Station where it was dumped directly alongside the trash pile within the transfer station. Mr. Capasso stated that trash dumped at this location is then systematically bull dozed into the large pile after which it is picked up for direct load into the landfill disposal trucks. He did not notice the 20 gallon drums in question however he was not specifically looking for the drums. Mr. Capasso reported that although Miele generally has rules that restrict the disposal of items like metal drums, on these days, no material was restricted during the dumping process. He stated that such restriction rarely occurs and, when it does, it typically involves tire disposal. Mr. Capasso stated that no material was removed from the truck prior to the dumping at the transfer station (such as for scrape reclaim, etc.).

Mr Capasso reported that his estimated dumping times for Saturday and Tuesday were 1030 and slightly after noon respectively. He stated that dumping at the transfer station is not allowed past noon on Saturdays and 3PM on weekdays.
