Yesterday we met with all the Region II licensing managers here in Atlanta. They brought up several issues that I need to get them answers for....additionally, I expect that they will again bring these issues up at next month's NEI/licensing manager's meeting in Arlington. If you could give me some answers that would be very helpful...

Manual Actions

1. a. If sometime down the road (after a rulemaking plan) we are going to give discretion, then why not give it now. They believe that we are going to go through a lot of enforcement for something that we know will be ok later.

1.b. This also applies to reportability. If it's not outside their design basis or a non-compliance they wouldn't have to report a manual action condition. They don't want to report these issues.

2. Will they have to keep any corrective action document open until the new rule? or can they do the corrective actions and close the document. We can go back and inspect what they did.
