### **MEETING SUMMARY**

LICENSEE: CONSTELLATION GENERATION GROUP

FACILITY: CALVERT CLIFFS, UNITS 1 & 2

SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF APRIL 14, 2005, ANNUAL ASSESSMENT MEETING WITH  
CONSTELLATION GENERATION GROUP

On April 14, 2005, at 6:30 p.m., an Annual Assessment Meeting was conducted at the Holiday Inn, Prince Frederick, MD, between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Constellation Generation Group (Constellation). The NRC requested the meeting with Constellation management to discuss NRC's assessment of the safety performance of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant for calendar year 2004.

The NRC presented and discussed its assessment of the safety performance of Calvert Cliffs Units 1 and 2 for the period between January 1 through December 31, 2004. The NRC presentation included background on both plants, performance assessment results, an overview of calendar year 2005 planned inspections and oversight, and a discussion of general NRC issues. As part of this regulatory performance meeting, Constellation presented an overview of their performance.

NRC's assessment letter can be found in ADAMS with an accession number of ML050610737. The meeting notice with the attached meeting agenda, and the meeting slides can be located in ADAMS with an accession number of ML050760441 and ML050760473.

The time selected for this meeting was intended to increase attendance and encourage more participation from the public, however, only four members of the public attended. The public members who attended indicated they would prefer a meeting in the afternoon in lieu of the early evening hours. All the members of the public that attended were part of the Maryland Emergency response Organization and would prefer to attend during normal working hours. The public observed this meeting and were offered the opportunity to communicate with the

NRC regarding Constellation's performance at Calvert Cliffs and the role of the agency in ensuring safe plant operations. At the end of the meeting between the NRC and Constellation, the NRC answered questions from the public.
