Subject: Licensee's request for clarification.

<u>Summary</u>: Mr. Davis informed me that he had questions concerning some of the paragraphs in the deficiency letter that he received recently. Questions 7 and 9 dealt with how the licensee performed surveys of the areas where licensed material was kept. Mr. Davis indicated that wipes were taken of the equipment and sent to a licensed vendor for analysis. He questioned me about the requirement on performing tests of where the equipment was stored every three months since he can not find the document referenced in the deficiency letter. I replied that the document was the Sealed Source and Device Registration Sheet which the Army had to submit to the NRC in order to have the devices approved for use. If he wants a copy of the document, then he should contact the Army or perform a FOIA. Question 8 was a request for a description of the licensee's radiation monitoring program since one of the duties mentioned in the application was retrieving monitoring devices from employees. Mr. Davis stated that personnel do not receive more than 10 percent of the allowable exposure to occupationally exposed individuals and, therefore, do not need to be monitored. Mr. Davis stated that if he had any other questions regarding the deficiency letter, he would get back in touch with me before sending in his response.
