Liability for hypothetical accidents at licensed uranium enrichment facilities would be dependent on the accident circumstances. However, if the responsibility is that of the licensee, LES will have liability insurance coverage. Note that under 10 CFR 140.13b, uranium enrichment facilities are required to have liability insurance. Section 1.2.2 of the Safety Analysis Report discusses how LES intends to meet these liability insurance requirements.
