- (1) *Radiation Safety Committee duties: Please commit to review and approval of permitted program and procedural changes prior to implementation.*

The Radiation Safety Committee duties are stated on Page 5 of the application. Item 1 should read as follows: (The RSC shall) review and approve all permitted program and procedural changes prior to implementation.

- (2) *Please commit to the following statement: Before being named as the RSO, future RSOs will have successfully completed the training described in Appendix G in NUREG – 1556, Vol. 5, dated October 1998. Within 30 days of naming a new RSO, we will submit the RSO's name to NRC for inclusion in our license.*

Section 7.3 Radiation Safety Officer (Page 6 of the application)

Management will ensure that future RSOs have successfully completed training consistent with the requirements of Appendix G in NUREG – 1556, Vol. 5, dated October 1998. Specific RSO training will also be a requirement, unless education and experience meet requirements in advance. RML will submit the RSO's name to NRC for inclusion in the license within 30 days of naming a new RSO.
