Subject: Amendment request; clarification of 35.300 authorization			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>Licensee request authorization for use of an inpatient room for I-131 patients who cannot be released under 10 CFR 35.75. While reviewing license file, I noted that current amendment (renewal from January 2005) limits 35.300 to I-131 only. Previous amendments and renewal request were for all of 35.300, not just limited to I-131. I can find no documentation of the basis for limiting 35.300 to I-131 only. Please clarify.</p> <p>Suzanne said licensee's wishes authorization for all of 35.300, same as in past amendments and same as requested in renewal. She believes there may have been some confusion at the time of renewal when authorization for 35.300 was limited to releasable patients only.</p> <p>[Yesterday I spoke with RI Medical Branch member who was primary reviewer on renewal. They recalled intending to limit the 35.300 authorization to releasable patients only, but not to I-131 only.]</p>
